

The Wilderness Sanctuary

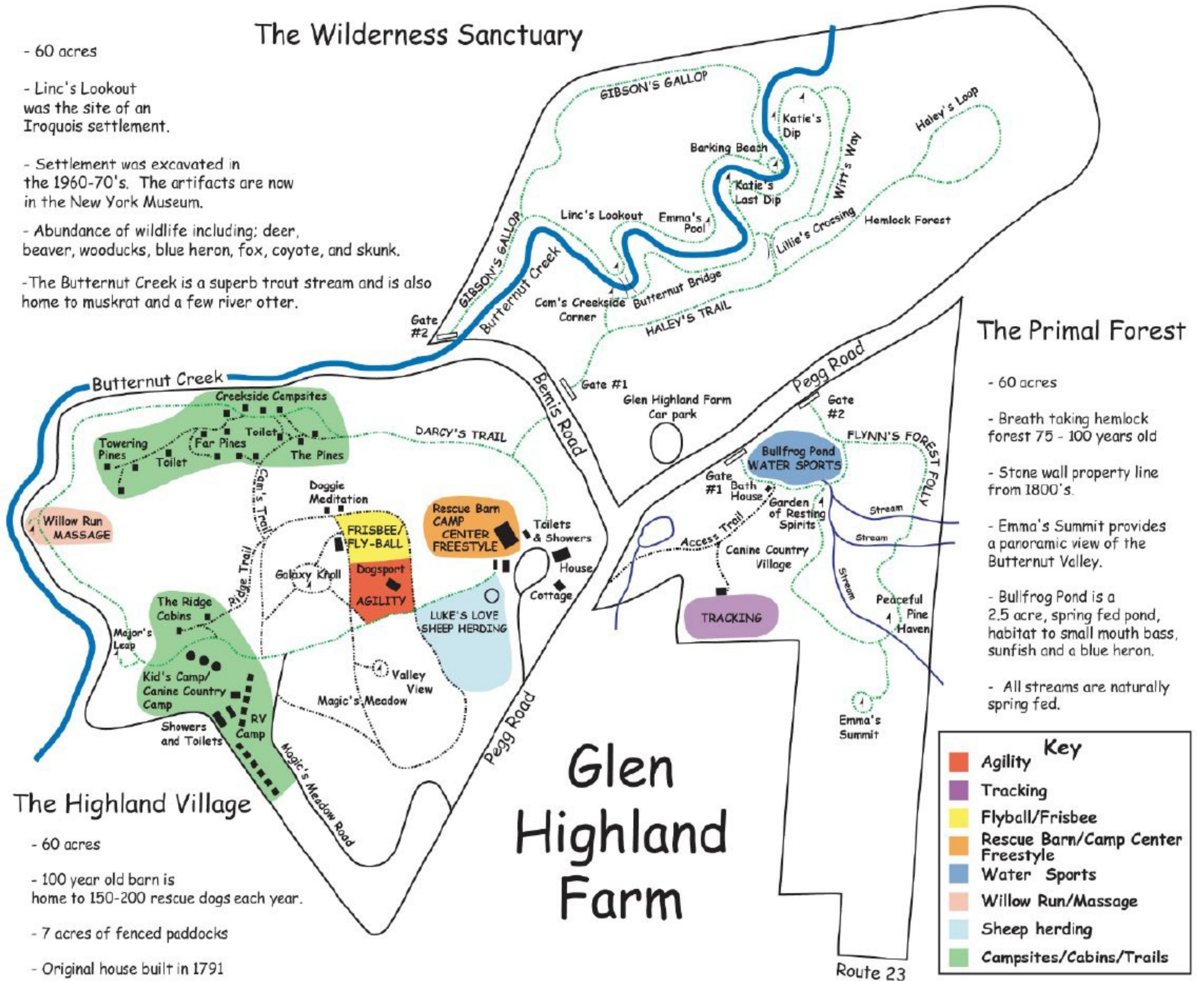
- 60 acres

- Linc's Lookout was the site of an Iroquois settlement.

- Settlement was excavated in the 1960-70's. The artifacts are now in the New York Museum.

- Abundance of wildlife including: deer, beaver, wooducks, blue heron, fox, coyote, and skunk.

- The Butternut Creek is a superb trout stream and is also home to muskrat and a few river otter.



The Primal Forest

- 60 acres

- Breath taking hemlock forest 75 - 100 years old

- Stone wall property line from 1800's.

- Emma's Summit provides a panoramic view of the Butternut Valley.

- Bullfrog Pond is a 2.5 acre, spring fed pond, habitat to small mouth bass, sunfish and a blue heron.

- All streams are naturally spring fed.

The Highland Village

- 60 acres

- 100 year old barn is home to 150-200 rescue dogs each year.

- 7 acres of fenced paddocks

- Original house built in 1791
